#### A SPLASH OF A TIME AT THE BRIDPORT AUSTRALIA DAY SPLASH!

Yes is it is on again this year...

With the huge success of the last 2 events, the Bridport Surf Life Saving Club will again host the popular Australia Day Splash on Friday 26th January.

The Bridport SLSC was approached by Dorset Council to take over the Splash in 2016, and the club decided to host the community event, and with that was the decision to change the venue to Gofton's Beach.

Bridport President and Splash Coordinator, Derek Arnold, said the move from Croquet Lawn Beach to Gofton's Beach allowed for more recreation room, parking space and easy access to toilets as well as being closer to the shopping strip in Bridport.

"We also found it easier to patrol the event with resources and equipment at our fingertips," he said.

The Bridport SLSC have a great program planned for the day with the traditional games, activities and competitions, as well as some of the new events introduced last year.


