Bridport Holiday Park Southern Zone Redevelopment Commences

Dorset Council has recently commenced work on the

Southern Zone of its redevelopment of the Bridport Holiday Park.

Vegetation has been cleared to allow for the construction of new office and accommodation buildings for the new caretakers.

Dorset Community Services Manager Susie Bower said that once the new buildings are complete in March 2014, a revegetation program will be implemented to enhance the area.


"A detailed plan encompassing all works in the Bridport

Holiday Park's Southern Zone will be complete in September 2013. This will include redeveloping the Southern Zone camping sites which will commence after the peak summer season in May 2014.





Dorset Council Introduces Lifetime Dog Registrations



Dorset Council today announced the introduction of Lifetime Dog Registrations for Dorset dog owners.

Life Time Dog Registrations are now available to dog owners whose dog has been micro chipped and de-sexed at a cost of \$170. The rate is discounted for pensioners to \$100 and a refund of \$70 will be available if the dog passes away or if the dog relocates from the municipality within 3 years of the registration date.

Dorset Council Animal Control Officer Wayne Churchill said that Annual Registrations are still available and details can be found on the Dorset Council website.

"The main benefit to dog owners will be convenience; they will no longer have to go through the process of registering their dog every year and it will save money in the long run."

Council provides a range of services to the community in relation to dogs; including the relocation of dogs, dealing with complaints and the regulation of dog kennels. The purpose of dog registration fees is to obtain a contribution from dog owners towards the cost of providing these services.

"Council conducts a number of community programs to better educate the community on responsible pet ownership including micro chipping and dog registration days throughout the municipality, the Delta Dog Safe program which visits local schools, and the free community event in Bridport in March Dogs Day Out." Mr Churchill said.

It is mandatory that dogs are micro-chipped and all dogs over the age of six months are required by law to be registered with their local council.

- Sunday 27th October will see runners registering for the event on the Village Green, Main St. Bridport.
- This year the event will start and finish on the Village Green.
- A short 2km course will be introduced this year for Primary School aged participants. Starting and finishing on the Village Green they will run along the Foreshore track to the start of the walking track (near Barnetts Fish Factory towards the Brid River bridge). Entry is \$2 per participant. All runners will need to register and have their entry form signed by a parent/ guardian over the age of 18 yrs.
- Prize money will be distributed between 1st, 2nd and 3rd male and female places for the (10 km) run.
- Entry for both senior and U16's this year is \$10 per participant. Entry forms will be available to download from the Bridport Walking Track website in the coming months. All runners need to register, with U16/s having a parent/guardian sign their form
- The organisers are looking forward to making this a family friendly event. Come and play in the Zorb balls, ride the motorized skate boards, enjoy a feast from the BBQ whilst you wait for your favourite runner to charge across the finish line.
- Walkers, walking groups are invited to amble along the track taking in the sites along the way. Register & \$5 entry fee
- Start times: Registration will open at 8 am.
- 9 am the walkers will head off, 10 am both senior and U16's will head off, and once the track is clear of the main event the junior short course runners will be invited to line up at the starting line for their event.
- Presentations will be held by about 11.30 am


