CLUB GETS A LIFT

You can hardly have missed the fact that the Bunker Club in Main Street is going up in the world, with construction of a second storey well under way. The Bridport Ex-Services, Bowls and Community Club were successful in obtaining a grant for the work from the Tasmanian Government, which will be matched dollar for dollar by the Club.

The current single storey building, which dates from the 1970s, was always designed to have a second floor, and the Club has been talking about the extension for some years. Work began in early September, with local builder Brett Williams. Voluntary labour from Club members will be used for interior finishing touches.

The extension will consist of a large function room with amazing views over Anderson Bay. Two decks will overlook the ocean and the bowling green. The function room will be serviced by kitchen facilities, a bar area and toilets. Access will be either via a stairwell or, in a first for Bridport, a full sized lift.

The area will be used by the Bridport Bowling Club in bowling season but will also be available for community functions and as an extra space for Dianne and Dion who run the Bunker Club bar and restaurant downstairs. (see photo page 8)

THE NORTH EAST FIELD NATURALISTS CLUB

Debbie Searle led the September Field Nats. walk in the forest at Weldborough where the focus was on ferns.

Thirteen species of fern were identified. The forest fern most people are familiar with is the Manfern – *Dicksonia antarctica* and it was probably the most common one seen, but the names of some of the others make them easy to identify. For example – Batswing fern, Finger fern, Filmy fern and Fishbone fern.

The next outing is into the Mt. William National Park on October the 13th. We will meet at the Ranger's Centre [on the C845 road] at the entrance to Mt. William National Park at 10 am. (Entrance fees will apply).

We will climb Mt. William, then walk to Boulder Point on the coast in the afternoon.
