### NOVEMBER STROLL

The walk up Mt. Maurice on the Diddleum Plain was very successful with members observing Schlerophyll forest species side by side with, and sometimes inter-mixing with, rainforest species. Mt Maurice has a rounded top rather than a craggy, peaky top, is covered with Richea scoparia and littered with sandstone outcrops. It is quite unusual in that respect. From its height of a mere 1122metres, and because vegetation is so low, it is possible to get a 360 degree panoramic view out to the Furneaux Islands, across to Mt. Barrow nearby, and over to all the other high spots in the North East.

### DECEMBER STROLL

The last outing of the year will be December 8th, a gentle downhill walk of approximately 8km in a similar area. We will meet at the Springfield Hatchery, South Springfield and car pool there up onto the Diddleum Plain to the start of the walk. After the walk, there will be a barbeque at the Hatchery.
