Bridport Girl Guides have had a very successful start to the year with fund raising. This has allowed them to support their guides financially for their annual Unit Camp held in June, which everyone thoroughly enjoyed.

They were successful in gaining a Dorset Council Small Grant of \$2000 that has paid for a heat pump at their Guide House (which is shared with Bridport Playgroup). Guides had to contribute the balance for its installation .

Recently a picnic table and seating has been purchased and installed by the Dorset Council in the Lions Children's Adventure Playground, near the flying fox. Guides thought it was a way they could put back into the community and thank the community for their on going support. A plaque will be added to it later in the year.

Bridport CWA has been very generous in giving the Guides \$2000 which has been spent on 2 sewing machines and threads etc. in the hope that these girls will be the future CWA members. Nanny Roo (Viv Sarich) is very busy teaching all the girls how to sew.

The younger Puggle Guides are learning some handcraft and the older guides are using the machines and have been making pillows, aprons, travel pillows and heat packs and are doing very well.

Guide parents and older guides recently catered a 2 course meal for a combined Lions dinner, which went well. Thank you to Lauren Smylie and leaders and guides for their help and thank you to Lions for giving us that opportunity to fund raise.
