Juniors urged to 'Run for Fun'

Junior runners are being encouraged to take on the course for the Musselroe Wind Farm Bridport 10 Plus Fun Run.

Organisers say, while last year's overall entry of nearly 150 was good, the ranks of 12 to 15-year olds were a bit thin.

Run co-ordinator Gina Scott said there was plenty of incentive offered by generous sponsorship from the Everyday IGA Supermarket and Harcourts Real Estate contributing towards an \$1800 prize pool for open and under 16 male and female placegetters.
